


# How to sort your garbage and put it out correctly

Illegal dumping and outdoor burning are illegal and punishable by law. Never do this.

Categories	Main types of waste collected		Precautions and Etiquette When Disposing of Garbage	
Burnable waste	<b>Kitchen garbage, leather goods, Rubber, cloth, disposable diapers, Trees, grasses, and dead leaves (designated bags for burnable waste)</b> 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please drain kitchen garbage thoroughly.</li> <li>Please remove dirt from disposable diapers.</li> <li>Futons, rugs, mattresses, carpets, and electric carpets are "Bulky waste". (Remove the electrical cord and place it in "small appliances".)</li> <li>The "collection ticket" (sticker) is for trees and twigs only. Cut the tree branches to a diameter of 3 cm or less and the length 1 m or less, bundle with a diameter of 30 cm or less, and put a garbage collection ticket on them.</li> <li><b>Disposable lighters cannot be disposed of in the burnable waste. Please bring them to the Sakai City Hall.</b></li> </ul>	
	<b>Edible oil</b> 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please put it in a plastic bottle or other container and bring it to City Hall and branch offices during business hours (8:30-17:15 *except weekends and holidays).</li> <li>If you solidify it with a coagulant, or absorb it with paper (newspaper, paper towels), dispose of it as burnable waste.</li> </ul>	
Recyclable materials	Wastepaper	Newspapers and inserts	 <p>Please dispose of newspaper inserts together with the newspaper.</p> <p>You may also hand in newspapers at recycling drives held at local schools.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tie it crosswise with a paper string, etc.</li> <li>Remove vinyl, gum tape, etc. from corrugated board.</li> <li>Wash, dry, and flatten (open out) the cartons before putting them out.</li> <li>Paper cartons with silver lining inside should be disposed of as burnable waste.</li> <li>Miscellaneous paper refers to recyclable paper other than newspapers, magazines, cardboard, and paper cartons.</li> </ul>

	Plastic	PET bottles		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remove caps and labels. Dispose of them as "Plastic containers/packaging &amp; plastic products."</li> <li>Items with a plastic mark, such as bags, labels/cups, trays/bottles, etc., should be 100% plastic-based, free of metal/rubber parts, batteries, etc., and small enough to fit in the specified bag, with a side length of less than 50cm.</li> <li>Dispose of heat-resistant plastic products with burnable waste.</li> <li>If the stain cannot be removed by washing with water, please dispose of it in burnable garbage.</li> <li>You can also dispose of snack bags and other items with an aluminum coating on the inside.</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;">Uniform catchphrase for reducing plastic waste in the prefecture <b>"Let's reduce plastic waste and protect the future of Fukui"</b></p>
		Plastic containers, packaging, and plastic products	 <p>Please wash the inside of bottles before taking them out.</p> <p>Empty the contents.</p>	
	Non-returnable glass bottles	Brown	 <p>You don't have to remove hard-to-remove paper labels.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wash inside and put in containers of each color.</li> <li>Remove the cap.</li> <li>Bottles other than food and drink, such as bottles of cosmetics, are non-burnable garbage.</li> <li>Put clear/colorless bottles in the white container (white bin).</li> <li>Milky-white (opaque) bottles should be disposed of as non-burnable waste.</li> <li>If it is difficult to determine the color, see the bottle through the light to determine the color. If you don't know, put it in a black container.</li> </ul>

Non-burnable waste	<b>Breakables (glass/ceramics) and other metal items</b> <small>(glass and ceramics)  <small>(small appliances (excluding the four specified home appliances), metal products, umbrellas, knives, razors, bottle caps, crown caps, etc.)</small></small> 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>30cm or smaller in size</li> <li>If there are small pieces, put them in a plastic bag before setting them out.</li> <li>Small home appliances can also be placed in a special collection box.</li> </ul>	
Hazardous waste	<b>Ignitable hazardous waste</b> <small>(spray cans and cassette cylinders)</small>  <p>Be sure to puncture the cans in a well-ventilated area.</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use up the contents, puncture the can in a well-ventilated place, and put it into the designated collection container.</li> <li>Remove the cap and any detachable parts (spray button/nozzle).</li> </ul>	
	<b>Dry battery</b> 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Into containers at the Sakai City Hall.</li> <li>Do not dispose of disposable lighters in the "burnable waste".</li> <li>Please use up all the gas in the disposable lighter.</li> </ul>	
	<b>Disposable lighter</b> 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please separate them by type into collection containers at the Sakai City Hall.</li> </ul>	
Small appliances <b>Box collection</b>	<b>Fluorescent lamps, incandescent bulbs, mercury thermometers</b> <small>(not broken)</small>  <p>LED bulbs and broken fluorescent lamps cannot be recycled, so please dispose of them as non-burnable waste.</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Collection box installation location Sakai City Hall Main Office, Sakai City Hall Branch Offices.</li> <li>Only items that fit through the slot (40 cm x 20 cm).</li> <li>Remove the batteries.</li> <li>Please delete all personal data from the device before disposal.</li> </ul>	
	Bulky waste	<b>Digital cameras, game consoles, mobile phones, remote controls, hair dryers, notebook computers, etc.</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Collection box installation location Sakai City Hall Main Office, Sakai City Hall Branch Offices.</li> <li>Only items that fit through the slot (40 cm x 20 cm).</li> <li>Remove the batteries.</li> <li>Please delete all personal data from the device before disposal.</li> </ul>	
				<b>Cleaning center Personal carry-on (fee required)</b> Every week Monday through Friday and Second and fourth Sunday of each month 
<b>Items not collected by the city</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Desktop PC (PC main unit, display)</li> <li>Appliances recycled (air conditioners, televisions [including plasma and liquid crystal], refrigerators, washing machines, clothes dryers)</li> <li>Industrial waste, construction waste, roof tiles, concrete, tires, batteries, fire extinguishers, gas cylinders, wood with a diameter of 10 cm or more, motorcycles, etc.</li> </ul>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ask your dealer, manufacturer, or PC 3R Promotion Association (TEL 03-5282-7685) to collect desktops.</li> <li>Renet Japan Recycle Co., Ltd. collects products by express delivery.
