Category	Accepted Waste at Special Collection Points (Examples)	
Designated bag Burnable waste	Kitchen waste	Leftover food, tea leaves, lunch boxes, eggshells, seashells, empty cartons/packaging, food trays, plastic containers, wooden/plastic utensils, aluminum foil (if not cleanable), etc.
	Vinyl and paper waste	Candy bags, plastic bags, paper cups, outer boxes, newspapers, miscellaneous paper, cardboard, etc.
	Wood/Bamboo scraps & household items	Pruning waste, disposable heat packs, desiccants, medicated patches, paper diapers, etc.
	Textiles & footwear	Clothing, cushions, foot mats, slippers, leather shoes, boots, etc.
	Plastic items	CDs, VHS tapes, sponges, toys, bath mats, plastic containers, plastic sheets, EPS foam, etc.
	Leather & rubber items	Bags, gloves, belts, rubber cords, rubber bands, etc.
	PET bottles	Containers for juice, tea, soy sauce, mirin, etc.
Category	Accepted Waste at Special Collection Points (Examples)	
Designated bag Non-burnable waste	Ceramics	Bowls, tea cups, dishes, flower pots, etc.
	Glass and mixed items	Glass cups, glassware, window glass, mirrors, medicine/cosmetic bottles, etc.
	Metal items	Pots, kettles, buckets, cooking utensils, spoons, splatter guards, range sheets, scissors, paint tubes, powdered-milk cans, food cans, confectionery tins, etc.
	Small home appliances	Radio-cassette players, hair dryers, shavers, home game consoles, electric heaters, rice cookers, etc. ※Please cooperate as much as possible in the collection of small home appliances for recycling.
	Others	Umbrellas, wire, cords, kitchen knives, metal toys, etc. ※For long items such as wire, please cut them into pieces within 1 m before disposal.
	Cans	Empty drink cans (juice, beer, etc.)
	Glass bottles	Empty bottles for sake, beer, soy sauce, seasonings, juice, etc.
	Note: Aerosol (spray) cans	Aerosol (spray) cans and cassette gas cylinders are NOT collected here. Use up contents, puncture, and bring them to City Hall.
